'Straight from San Antonio' to Open in Mexico City

Ruiz-Healy Art announces "Straight from San Antonio," a collaborative exhibition, will open at Galería Karen Huber in Mexico City on Thursday, June 9, 2016. The exhibit will feature five artists on the Ruiz-Healy Art roster including: Cecilia Biagini, Jesse Amado, Nate Cassie, Ethel Shipton, and Constance Lowe.

This exhibit is a continuation of the partnership formed with Galería Karen Huber for the exhibition held at Ruiz-Healy Art in March, "Straight from Mexico City," which featured four artists from Karen Huber's gallery. Also organized by curator Octavio Avendaño Trujillo, Straight from San Antonio maintains the quest to question the cultural context of our time with a critical construction of identity set forth in a pictorial and sculptural practice.

Galería Karen Huber is a platform of contemporary art that engages with the production of curatorial projects that incorporate emerging artists in the national sphere. The Gallery has a residency program for artists around the world with the intention of extending the artistic panorama of the country and bringing an understanding of existing overseas paradigms to the Mexican public.
