Operated a ceramic art business from 1996-2006. The line of pottery was developed incorporating painting with large rustic red clay forms, with additions of clay floral elements, and slip painting. The overall effect was baroque and exuberant. I sold these functional pottery pieces at outdoor art shows, the American Craft Council show (Baltimore), and The Rosen show (Philadelphia), and then wholesale throughout the United States.
